Early registration ends June 6th!!!!

Early registration fee is \$15/child (ages 3½ - 5th grade) with \$45 family max.

After June 6th cost is \$20/child with \$60 family max.

Children born on or after 1/1/2007 are free. The Infant/Toddler and Preschool/Kindergarten Program are open to children of volunteers only.

Infant/Toddler Program: Infant, Crawlers, Walkers, 1 ½ -2 yr., 2-2 ½ yr., 2 ½- 3 1/2's

Preschool Program: 3 ½'s yrs old through Kindergarten 2010

Elementary I Program: Children entering 1st – 2nd grade in fall 2010

Elementary II Program: Children entering 3rd grade – 5th grades in fall 2010

Bring a New-To-Grace friend for free—first 200 bring a friend registrations (available at the kiosk in Town Square) will come for free! (1st – 5th graders only)

ENTER AND EXIT

Please park on the northeast side of the building or in the north lot. Please enter and exit through the main covered entrances on the east side. Please do not use the east doorway by the office in order to minimize disturbance to staff.

DROP-OFF

Infant, Toddler, Preschool, and Kindergarten

The Infant through Kindergarten classrooms will open at 8:45 AM. Due to space limitations Grace Kids Camp room assignments may not correlate directly to Grace weekend rooms. You will receive an email the week prior to GKCamp, telling you which room your child will be in. Thank you for your understanding with this!

This year we will be using electronic check-in for all children and volunteers.

Scan your GKC check-in card at the kiosks to check-in your children and/or yourself when you arrive. The system will print nametags automatically. Children's nametags will have a security code printed on them. Two parent receipt tags will also print with the matching security code. These receipt tags must be presented to check-in and check-out your child. This is how we can ensure children are picked up by authorized people only. If you lose your tag, a photo ID will be required to check-out your child. **If you do not already have a GKC check-in card, please pick one up at the Grace Kids Camp kiosk in Town Square prior to the first day of camp.**

PICK-UP

Infant/ Toddler

Children in the Infant/Toddler Program must be picked up by 12:15 PM. You must have the matching parent receipt tag to pick up your child.

Preschool/ Kindergarten-

All children in Preschool and Kindergarten must be checked out of their rooms by 12:15 from the following locations. If someone other than a parent or guardian is going to pick up your child, they must have a matching parent receipt sticker. Check out your children at the exit door after you have located them in the room. You will need the parent receipt tags you receive at electronic check-in.

Elementary I and Elementary II

All children in the Elementary I and II programs must be picked up at 12:00 from the following locations.
