

# GROUP ROLES



## Who fits these functions in your group?

God wants everyone to have a part in His church. Since your group embodies the church in your neighborhood, you should work towards everyone having a role to be involved. Use this exercise to help identify what roles fit your group members.

Instructions:

1. Give everyone a worksheet and explain the potential roles. Hosting and facilitating are roles that rotate and should pass among all members.
2. Spend 5-10 minutes independently filling in group member names who you think might fit these roles, including a role for yourself. Roles can be shared by 2-3 people, so you may have more than one name in a role. People may function in more than one role, so you can write their name in more than one place.
3. Spend 10-15 minutes sharing your results and why you chose the people for their roles.
4. Based on your exercise, go back and discuss what roles group members might be willing to function in.

Leadership	Primary shepherd & contact with church	
Organization	Schedule meetings, plan special events	
Prayer	Track and distribute prayer requests	
Worship	Lead group into praise and adoration	
Service	Plan and coordinate service projects with group	
Administration	Update Group Finder online database	
Relationships	Champion sharing times, life stories and socials for men, women and the group	
Childcare	Coordinate care and involvement of children in the group
